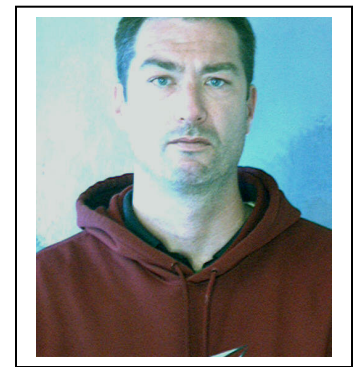

### **SUSPECT IN MURDER AT PEACHTREE ROAD TEXACO STATION SURRENDERS TO DEPUTY SHERIFFS**

**DECATUR, GA** -- Yesterday (March 23) murder suspect Cayles Nathan Berry of Cumming surrendered himself to DeKalb County Sheriff's Office Fugitive Squad deputies at an undisclosed location. Thirty-six year old Berry was wanted for the March 12, 2009, murder of Allan Wolfenbarger, who was shot behind the Texaco gas station at 4369 N. Peachtree Road. Wolfenbarger's last known address is Oakwood (Hall County).

Berry is being held in the DeKalb County Jail without bond.

According to the police report and criminal arrest warrant, witnesses saw Berry fleeing the scene in a vehicle, while the victim was found lying near the entrance of the gas station. Berry was identified by surveillance video from the scene, which also showed the two men together earlier inside the store. Friends and family confirmed that the victim was meeting the accused for a drug transaction, according to the warrant.
