## ON-SITE VISITATION CENTER CLOSED, SOME INMATE PROGRAMS SUSPENDED

During this public health crisis, we are taking extraordinary measures to control the possibility of inmate exposure to the COVID-19 virus. As a precaution, we are temporarily suspending some of the inmate services and programs that involve interaction with persons from outside the agency. The following changes are in effect immediately and until further notice:

<u>On-Site Video Visitation</u> - The DeKalb County Jail On-Site Video Visitation Center will be closed temporarily. Inmates will be allowed temporary use of the Remote Video Visitation service for their approved visitors. Inmates will receive one (1) free remote visit per week, per inmate at no cost to the caller.

Options for Living & Learning Classes are suspended.

<u>Chaplains</u> visitations by volunteers are suspended but emergency services will continue to be available to inmates and employees.

<u>Administration Lobby Access</u> is discontinued temporarily. Persons visiting the Sheriff's Office Headquarters (Administrative) Building on Memorial Drive will be directed to enter through the Jail Lobby on the Camp Road (east side) of the complex.

Inmate Commissary Services are suspended until April 7, 2020.
